

The Summit County Summer Youth Employment Program is underway and we are **seeking employers to serve as worksites** for youth workers.



Build your work skills. **Shape your future.**

There is NO cost or liability to employers

The county wishes to secure work opportunities with both large and small employers in the private, public, and nonprofit sectors.

- Youth workers will be age 14 – 17.
- Youth workers will be paid by a county-contracted payroll service to cover wages and Worker's Compensation expenses.
- There will be no financial commitment or responsibility for any organization to bring youth workers on board.
- Employment will begin June 10 and conclude August 2.
- Youth employees will work up to 15 hours weekly.
- Youths will be required to complete an additional 5-hour a week in work-readiness courses.
- Employer responsibilities include providing a valuable work experience to youth, basic supervision of youth, and e-mailing or faxing time sheets at the conclusion of each two-week pay period.
- A worksite orientation will be held the week of June 3—employers are strongly encouraged to attend.
- Worksites may request reimbursement for basic tools, uniforms, and other items purchased for youth that are needed to do their jobs.
